DIGITAL IMAGE RESIZE IN LIGHTROOM

DIGITAL IMAGES must be resized to fit inside a box with: a maximum WIDTH of 1600 pixels and a maximum HEIGHT of 1200 pixels. Therefore images in a portrait format must be no taller than 1200 pixels high.

Open Lightroom and highlight your image in the Develop Module

EITHER :

- If you wish to keep your originals safe, I suggest creating a virtual copy of your image before you resize
- To do this, Right-Click on your image in the Film Strip and click on 'Create a Virtual Copy' on the cursor menu.
- A new image will appear to the right on the film strip.
- This will allow you to add sharpening and other processing prior to Export
