

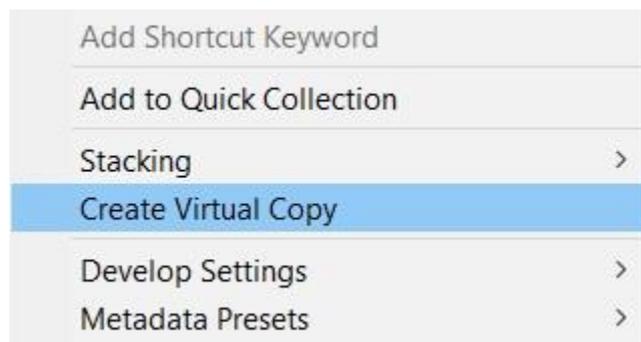
DIGITAL IMAGE RESIZE IN LIGHTROOM

DIGITAL IMAGES must be resized to fit inside a box with:
a maximum WIDTH of 1600 pixels and a maximum HEIGHT of 1200 pixels.
Therefore images in a portrait format must be no taller than 1200 pixels high.

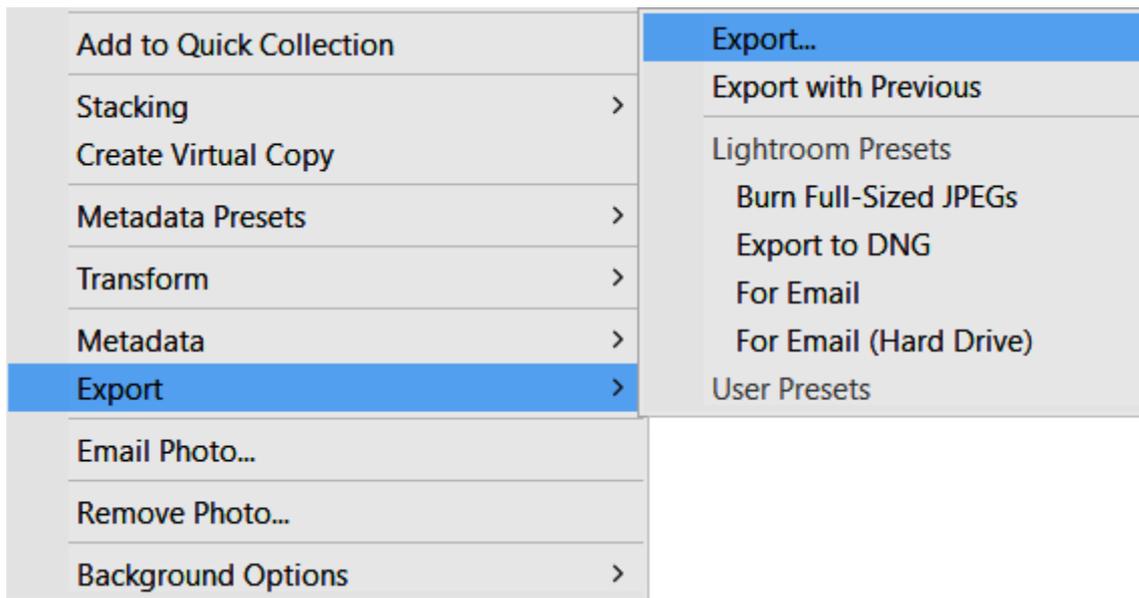
Open Lightroom and highlight your image in the Develop Module

EITHER :

- If you wish to keep your originals safe, I suggest creating a virtual copy of your image before you resize
- To do this, Right-Click on your image in the Film Strip and click on 'Create a Virtual Copy' on the cursor menu.
- A new image will appear to the right on the film strip.
- This will allow you to add sharpening and other processing prior to Export

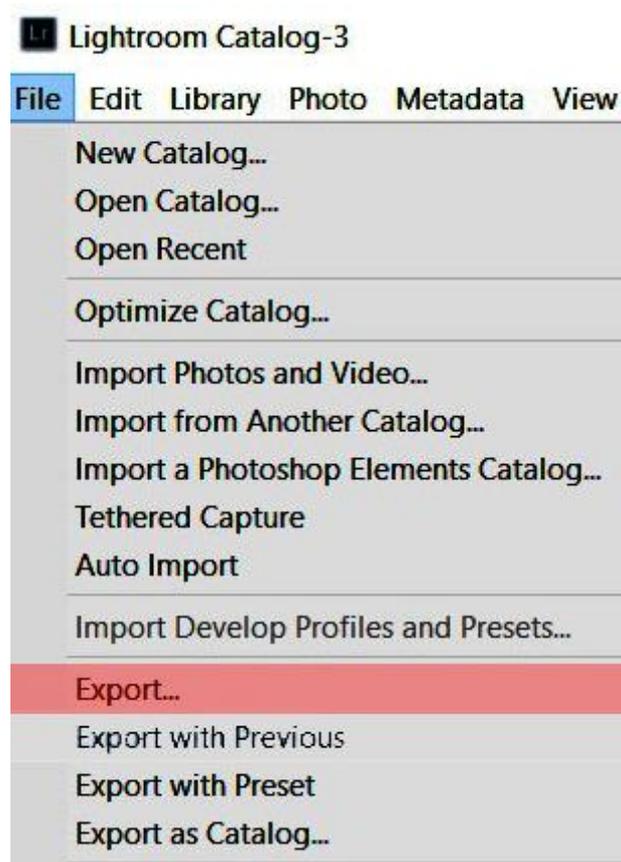


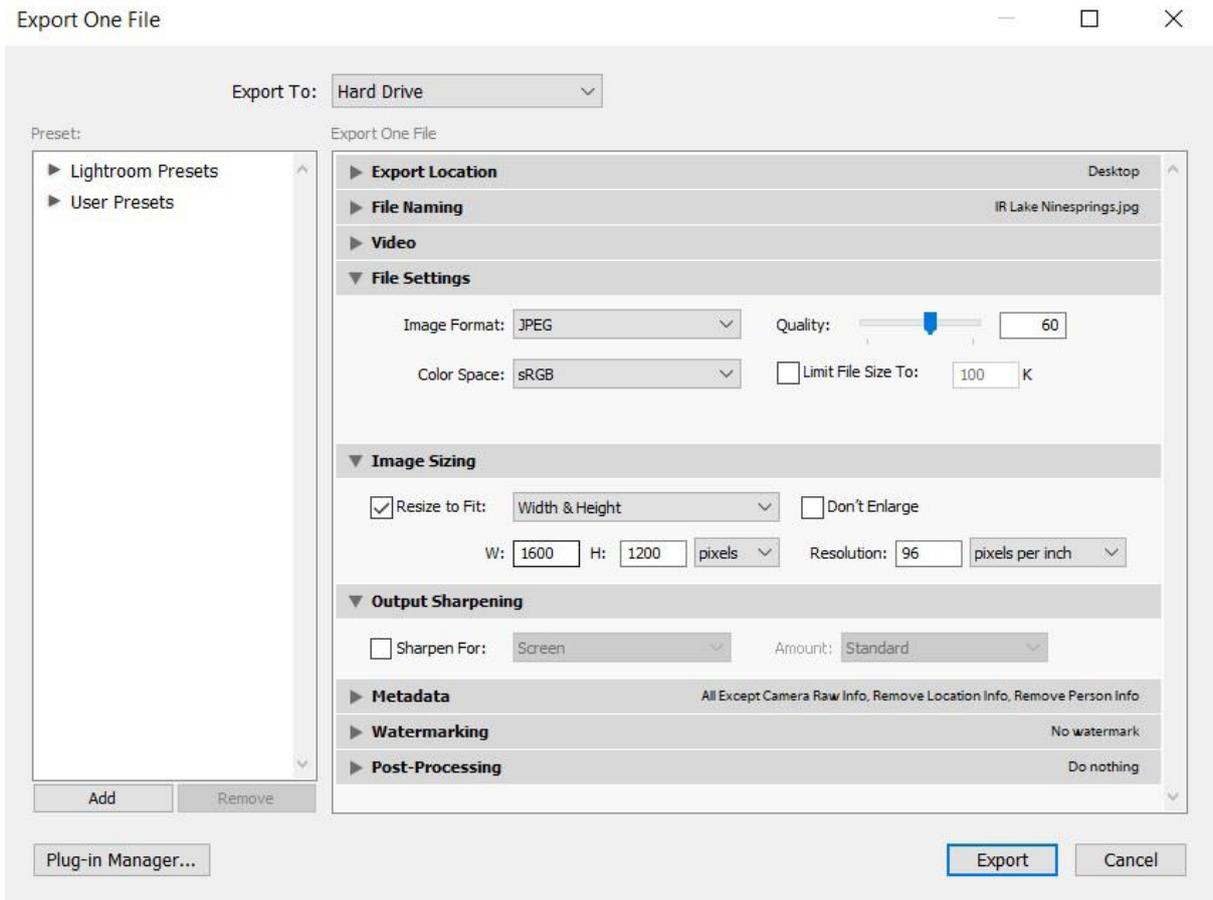
After any further processing, right-click the image again and select Export and the Export dialogue box will appear as below.



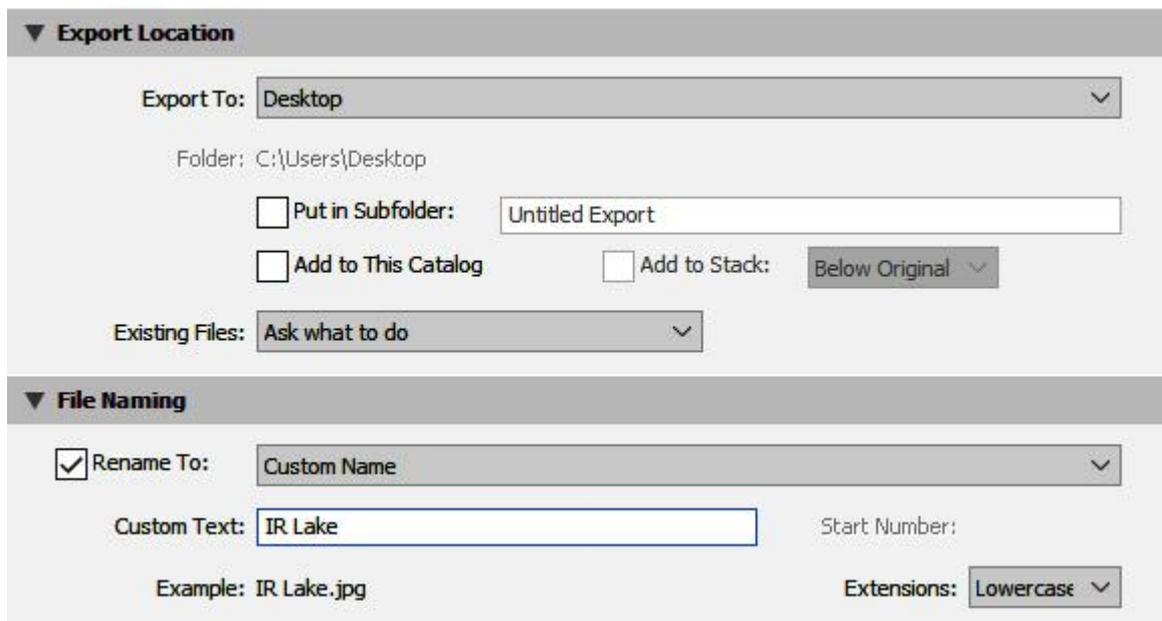
OR :

Go to FILE > EXPORT and the Export dialogue box will appear as below.





Lightroom's Export Dialogue box



Firstly, in the EXPORT LOCATION area specify the destination of the resized image then rename the file as required by Photoentry

▼ **File Settings**

Image Format: ▼

Use the down arrows to set the Image Format and Color Space to JPEG and sRGB

▼ **Image Sizing**

Resize to Fit: ▼

W: H: ▼

Click Resize To Fit checkbox
Select WIDTH & HEIGHT using the dropdown arrow
Enter 1600 in the Width box and 1200 in the Height box

Simply press the export button to create the resized image file
